CSPD Oversight and Integration



- Manuscript submitted, Establishing Knowledge and Skills for Service Coordinators in Early Intervention, to Infants and Young Children
- Manuscript, Early Intervention Leadership: Strategies and Collaborations, revised and resubmitted to DEC Leadership Monograph
- National collaboration with DEC workgroup for EI/ECSE Standards position statement accepted by the DEC Executive Board
- New Social-Emotional Learning Path <u>available now</u>. There are seven pathways to explore: Introduction to Social Emotional Development, Temperament, Understanding Behavior, Attachment, Attunement and Responsive Interactions, Trauma, and Stress and Trusting Relationships.
- Presented session, What is Early Intervention and What's Your Role?, at the Infant/Early Childhood Mental Health Conference
- Social-Emotional ECHO (Extension for Community Health Outreach), second cadre began on 3/3/22 with 30 participants. Four of five sessions completed.
- Developed six new infographics as part of the Service Coordination Materials Task Team.
- Completed the first cohort of the 6-month Dare to Lead El Leadership Book Study
- Released Episode 4: Supporting the Parent-Child Relationship in the EI on the Fly Podcast Tele-Intervention Series
- Submitted manuscript, Aligning Professional Development with Knowledge and Skills for New Service Coordinators, which describes research on the Kaleidoscope service coordination training, to Infants & Young Children
- Growing Brain for New Early Interventionists short course ended with 30 participants.
