CSPD Oversight and Integration

- El/Preservice Consortium and colleagues applied and were awarded an OSEP grant to support community college faculty to prepare preservice students. This is a \$1 million, 5 year grant with an overarching goal to grow the El and ECSE workforce.
- Equity in EI ECHO ended in July. Evaluation data is being compiled.
- Manuscript, Aligning Professional Development with Knowledge and Skills for New Service Coordinators, has been accepted for Infants & Young Children, with a publication date of January 2024.
- Staff presented, Understanding Behaviors: Triggers, Reflections, and Expectations, for the Piedmont VAIMH group. The session is recorded here.
- SSIP Pyramid Model Work Group meets monthly. The group is learning about the Pyramid Model framework and the correlations between adult learning principles and VA's evidence-based El practices.
- The next Division of Early Childhood Infant Mental Health Community of Practice quarterly meeting will be held on September 12, 2023 from 2-3:30 pm EST. Click here to register.

- SSIP Reflective Practice Work Group meets monthly. The group is developing a proposal for a pilot program investigating the effectiveness, feasibility, and sustainability of a site/program-based model for increasing the number of EI personnel with the IMH II credential. The proposed two-site pilot program includes job-embedded professional development, reflective supervision, and support for completing the IMH credentialing process at the Infant-Family Specialist Level.
