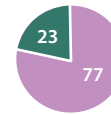

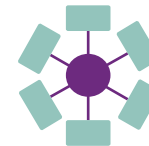

CSPD Oversight & Integration

- The PD team will represent VA, presenting several sessions and posters, at the **DEC Conference** October 1-4 in TX.
- Using data from staff and stakeholder interviews, new functional assessment **Learning Path** is under development.
- Through collaboration with ECMH Coordinator, Sept/Nov Talks on Tuesday webinars will support IMH endorsement candidates in needed content.
- Staff participating in ECMH conference planning for May 2020.
- Staff authored manuscript, **Implementing Recommended Assessment Practices in Early Intervention**, which will be part of the DEC Assessment monograph.
- Collaborated with three universities to develop email blasts re: EI content to embed in coursework this fall.
- Eight new videos about coaching and service coordination are now available on the [Videos page](#) and our VEIPD Videos YouTube channel.
- Staff is leading an SSIP workgroup to develop a resource package about coaching and early intervention in child care settings that can be shared with directors/owners and child care staff.
- Staff are co-leading the development team that has begun writing the DEC/ITCA joint position statement on service coordination
- Follow-up sessions with the last cohort of the **Coaching Implementation Support Project** and the May-June cohort of the adult learning course will be held in September.
- Staff are working with Part C staff to plan and coordinate the upcoming LSM meeting.
- Staff are working with Partnership staff to pilot an Autism ECHO project to improve early identification and diagnosis of young children with ASD



- The first 30 min **Resource Pop-Up** webinars will be held at 8:30am and 1:30 pm on September 12. Over 60 participants are registered so far!
