II. State and National Activities

- 1. Part C Updates
 - -Rate increase effective Jan 1st (12.5%); permanent
 - -Agency budgets includes an increase for Part C for FY25-26 (shy of \$2 million increase)
 - -TRAC-IT December 11, 2023 state-wide launch
 - -SSIP Continue to implement with focus on SE;

Workgroups have done foundational work on screening/assessment/; Pyramid Model, reflective supervision.

2024 will focus on implementation - what supports do providers need to implement recommendations for screening/assessment, Pyramid Model; and pilots in reflective supervision.

Moving into family support services on IFSP.

Workforce shortages are another big area of focus, including looking at what other states are doing and finding ways to reduce impact on our system.

Keynote - <u>Eric Litwin</u>, Author of Pete the Cat series, SE focus - nice match with SSIP for both Part C and Part B.


Ana Brecht suggested "Sensory Strategy Thought Bubbles for the El Practitioner". Ana will share with Lisa.

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III. Member Ideas and Input

- 1. VEIPD Highlights
 - EI/Preservice Consortium
 - -Local System Managers engaged in discussion/collaboration around pre-service field placements as a way to address shortage. Manuscript has been submitted.
 - -EI Field Placement Map has local systems with contacts along with pre-service programs and those contacts. Also has requirements for field placements.
 - -OSEP AA Personnel Prep grant update ODU, GM, VCU faculty will collaborate with 4 "under-resourced" community colleges to support community college faculty with embedding more EI content in syllabi, along with pathway to 4 year degree programs. Started Oct 1st, 5 year process. Beginning with a strengths/needs assessment, including community assessment.
 - Dimensions Short Course 7 session short course for new service providers focused on the fundamentals of EI. Pilot year. Running 8.31.23 -1.18.23
 - <u>Supporting Families in Early Intervention</u> Includes 3 organizations that support families. Each organization works closely with the others and will work to make sure the family gets to the right place for the support they need
 - <u>Sensory Difference Learning Path</u> Not yet available but collaborating with multiple projects to incorporate info on vision, hearing, and deaf-blindness.
