❖ Workplan Highlights

- CCSS2024 was successfully held July 16-18 in Roanoke. Approximately 450 in-person attendees and 100 virtual attendees.
- Kaleidoscope

- EI Certification Module Revisions
 - Teaming and Collaboration module is almost finalized.
 - Overview: Mission and Key Principles is 75% completed with goal to have launched 10/1/24.
- EI/Preservice Consortium
 - Presented to LSMs in June.
 - Had a networking and strategizing session with LSMs at CCSS.
 - Have added faculty from different disciplines (OT, PT, and ST) from various universities.
