Minutes

1. Welcome/Introductions & Celebrations/Announcements

- Congratulations to Cori Hill on your 19 year work anniversary with VCU.
- Patty had a very successful ASQ presentation with 553 participants and good feedback.

2. State and National Activities

a. Part C Update

■ Will be receiving 2 ½ million dollar additional funding from the American Rescue Act. It should be available July 1. More information to come as they receive it.

- New website as of last Friday. The new website uses the SquareSpace platform.<u>https://eivirginia.squarespace.com/</u>
- Making progress toward the new data system. Hopefully, they will be able to announce a new vendor in the next few months.

In the last 7 years, they have been working on the SSIP plan. That is coming to an end and they are working on generating input for the next quality improvement plan. The listening sessions for providers and local system managers start this Friday.

Creating Connections to Shining Stars (Virtual) - One day event held on July 15, 2021. Registration will open in early May. Robin McWilliam will be the Keynote speaker. There will be two one hour sessions that are EI related and two one hour sessions early special education related. The two EI sessions will be on Implicit Bias and the pandemic. The cost is \$25. It will be first come first serve and limited to 300 participants.

3. Work Plan Highlights

a. Highlight workplan activities

Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes (ECHOs) - both limited to 30 participants

- Leadership ECHO begins in May
- Social Emotional ECHO begins in June

b. Short Courses - Evidence to support short courses. Our team is responding to the evidence to offer more short courses to stay up to date with the latest research.

Growing Brain for New Early Interventionists - Registration filled in 2 hours with 20 people. There are 17 on the waiting list. Lisa will be offering an experienced Growing Brain course in the fall.

New Provider Short Course - Developing a 6 session short course for new practitioners (12 hours toward recertification). The first three sessions are concept sessions and the last three sessions are application sessions. Hoping to launch by the fall.

c. Leadership Book Study (Dare to Lead - Brene Brown) - Beginning in June and sessions are every three weeks. Telisha Woodfin (Part C TA Consultant) will be co-leading the book study. This is designed for people who are actively leading or supervising others.

e. Coaching Implementation Support Group (5th Cohort)
