PURPOSE OF ACTIVITY

The purpose of this activity is to review key terms associated with IFSP outcome development.



RESOURCES NEEDED

- Access to the Writing Functional IFSP Outcomes and Goals online module
- Handout Outcome Development Crossword Puzzle

SPECIFIC STEPS

- Before the meeting, instruct participants to complete the Writing Functional IFSP Outcomes and Goals online module on the VA Early Intervention eLearning Center. Ask participants to bring their certificates of completion to the meeting, or turn them in to you (or the supervisor) before the meeting.
- 2. Open the discussion about writing outcomes by inviting participants to share a few key ideas they remember from the module.
- 3. Pass out the handout to participants.
- 4. Instruct participants to work with a partner or individually to complete the crossword puzzle.
- 5. The first person/pair to accurately complete the puzzle wins a prize.
- 6. Review the answers using the Answer Key below with the large group. Discuss the items and answers as a review of content from the module.
- 7. Discuss the importance of developing individualized, meaningful outcomes that will guide the implementation of early intervention services.
- 8. To continue this discussion, consider reviewing some IFSP outcomes during the meeting from recent IFSPs as a group to discuss strengths and improvements.


